**6 Contract description**

The Financing agreement foresees the financing of 12 million EUR for the procurement of a daily snack of 75gm packets of fortified ( nutrient enriched) biscuits at 300 kcal/packet to be provided to each if the children of beneficiary schools (200 000 children in total) for a period of up to 4 years. The distribution of biscuits will be the responsibility of non-state actors selected separately through a call for proposals.
